## **DIRECTIONS:**

# From The Baltimore, Washington D.C., Or Richmond Area:

Take US 50 & 301 across the Bay Bridge. Follow US 50 East to Maryland 404 East. At Denton take Maryland 313 North. Turn right onto Maryland 317 which becomes Delaware 14 East. Take 14 East to Harrington. In Harrington, turn right onto US 13 South. Entrance is 1 mile on right. We are approximately 40 minutes from the Bay Bridge.

## From The Norfolk Area:

Cross the Bridge -Tunnel and follow US 13 North all the way to Harrington (approximately 2 1/2 hours from the Bridge -Tunnel).

From Ocean City, Maryland:
Take Rt 90 West to 589 North to 113 North. Follow 113 North to Route 14 West to the intersection of Rt 13 and the Town of Harrington. Turn left onto US 13 South. Entrance is 1 miles on right.

### From Points North:

Take the New Jersey Tumpike south to the Delaware Memorial Bridge or I-95 South through Wilmington. Then follow Route 13 South. Harrington is about 1 hour from the Delaware Memorial Bridge.

FACTS: DELAWARE STATE FAIRGROUNDS - The ideal place for a Rally. We have a 15,000 sq. ft. Exhibit Hall. Across from the Exhibit Hall is the Kent Pavilion - a perfect area for our vendors, protected from inclement weather (of course, we won't have any!). AND, right behind the Exhibit Hall is the *Midway Slots and Simulcast*. which houses The Midway International Buffet; Non-Stop Entertainment in the Carousel Lounge; and The Midway Doo-Wop Diner (a step back in time). NOTE: No one under 21 is permitted in the Midway Slots.
